cuyahoga community college: We have bridges to success workshops. Librarians participating

University of Saskatchewan: We have a first year course titled Learning to Learn available to some students, first-year and interest-based learning communities in 4 of 5 direct entry colleges, a badge program in the other, and others.

Jefferson Community & Technology College: mandatory 3 credit FYE class with a career research component

University of Oklahoma: gateway and freshman seminar

Mount Saint Mary College: We're launching a FY program that links Eng 101 and an introductory course in the disciplines, along with a personal librarian and study skills support.

University of Rochester: We have Early Connection Opportunity Program, Pre-major Advisers, Freshman Writing courses, study skills courses, CARE Network, several orientation programs

paul quinn college: Paul Quinn has a summer bridge program that runs for six weeks for incoming freshmen where the library does an orientation session with the students

Tri-County Technical College: WE have a Freshman Seminar course, linked courses (i.e. learning communities), service learning, experiential learning

cuyahoga community college: during the first several weeks of each semester we do the bridges.

University of Saskatchewan: Our first year learning communities are also linked courses.

Tri-County Technical College: experiential learning (aka travel abroad)

University of Rochester: Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning Study Skills course, workshops, first year orientation for minority and first generation college students

University of Rochester: Extended Scholar Program for ECO -mentoring first year students

University of Rochester: workshops and study groups linked to courses from our Center of Excellence in teaching and learning

University of Rochester: We have Freshman Abroad program

University of Rochester: Research grants for first year students

University of Rochester: Does this seminar also functions as a writing course?

University of Saskatchewan: does Developing Reflective Judgement have any tools to help assess information literacy?

University of Saskatchewan: Thanks.

University of Saskatchewan: dyslexic pi?

University of Rochester: During orientation, we (libraries) host a Parent's Breakfast, informing parents about ways the library can help their children

University of Oklahoma: woo hoo transcript !

Albany College of Pharmacy: Love the idea of involving parents when they are on campus. Have two Sneak Peaks for freshmen in Summer where we could try that then.

Monroe Community College: I think we need to design our spaces to be educational. so much learning today happens informally inside the library

University of Rochester: Decent. About 20 subject librarians talk with parents about their childrens' subject interests. We also hold a booth at the Tech Fair

University of Oklahoma: we have a librarian on location center in ... athletics/ business school/writing center

University of Rochester: We also attend the Resident Assistant (RA) fair.

Tri-County Technical College: We are starting a Roving Librarian program and station a librarian in the cafe.

Tri-County Technical College: We attend the club connection event.

University of Rochester: We have an idea to try out. Librarians collaborate with our Writing, Speaking and Argument Program instructors in a series of workshops to talk about information literacy and integrating it into the curriculum. Librarians and writing instructors would collaborate to attend and teach the sessions.

Albany College of Pharmacy: Any thoughts on how to get faculty buy in?

Jefferson Community & Technology College: How well does a research fair work?

University of Rochester: How did "mythbusters" class create the map for faculty research and for the campus tour?
